

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FLORIDA BAND TRIP

1. The presence of drugs or drug paraphernalia on or about a student is absolutely prohibited. If these are found on or about any student, said student will be sent home immediately at the expense of the parent.
2. Positively no drinking, smoking, or entering bars during the trip. Any student who uses or is found to possess liquor or tobacco products on the trip will be sent home at the expense of the parent.
3. No student is to leave his or her room after bed check in the evening. A student violating this rule will be sent home at the expense of the parent.
4. No student shall be in the room with members of the opposite sex, unless a chaperone is present. Any student in violation may be sent home depending on the severity of the infraction.
5. No student is to leave the hotel area unless accompanied by a chaperone.
6. No student will be allowed to remain at the hotel while the rest of the group is out, unless one of the chaperones remains with them.
7. Any student damaging property while on the trip will be responsible for paying for all damages.
8. Bag or room inspections may be held at any time by the chaperones. All bags, instruments, etc. will be inspected prior to departure.
9. All students will abide by the advice, judgement and directions of the adult chaperones.
10. All school rules apply while on the trip and the school will assign appropriate penalties for any violation of the rules in addition to the special trip penalties.
11. Violations of any of the above rules will likely result in the student not being allowed to participate in any additional student activities while on the trip.

Because of the number of students involved, the above rules will be strictly enforced. Infractions of rules #1, 2, or 3 will result in the student automatically being sent home on a bus, Amtrak train, or plane at the expense of the parents, accompanied by an adult chaperone. The parent will determine the mode of transportation. If any of the other rules are broken once, a judgement call will be made between directors and chaperones. If any student violates any rule for the second time, the student will be sent home at the expense of the parents.

The signature of the participating student and their parent at the bottom of this sheet constitutes agreement with, and intention to abide by statements, policies and rules set forth in this information packet. This signature indicates also that all information included in this packet has been read and approved by the parent. The signature of the parent is also necessary, giving permission to go on the Florida band trip.

I have read the information, agree to the stipulations, and give my child permission to participate in the group activities.

I have read the trip information and agree to follow all rules, regulations, and direction of the chaperones and directors.
